LOCATION

PRE-OPERATIVE CLASSES

PRE-ADMISSION TESTING

All surgical patients are encouraged to have their Pre-Admission Testing done at Suburban. This allows greater continuity of care by ensuring we have all the current medical information and lets our patients get acquainted with the hospital prior to their surgery. Patients are scheduled approximately one to two weeks prior to surgery, and receive a physical examination and any necessary tests such as blood work, urinalysis, chest X-ray or an EKG all in one place. Results are sent to their physician's office.

EXPERIENCED ORTHOPEDIC TEAM

The orthopedic surgical teams at Suburban are highly-skilled, experienced professionals who perform over 1,000 hip and joint replacements each year, in addition to many other advanced orthopedic procedures.

Following surgery, dedicated orthopedic nurse practitioners provide personalized post-operative medical care along with nurses and therapists specially trained in orthopedics with several decades of experience in the field. All orthopedic clinicians receive additional training on new techniques and technology regularly.

STATE-OF-THE-ART OPERATING SUITES

Millard Fillmore Suburban Hospital boasts 13 state-of-the-art operating suites, featuring computerized navigational equipment for the most precise fitting of artificial knee joints, specialized lighting, audio/video integration, touch screen paging system and a variety of clinical equipment. The management systems, or booms, installed in the operating rooms are moveable equipment towers suspended from the ceiling, making the environment much safer and more efficient for the surgical team.

MODERN FACILITY AND COMFORT

Throughout the entire procedure, loved ones are kept up-to-date on a patient's status and whereabouts with our white board tracking system, all while they wait in our comfortable surgical waiting area with wireless access and computer charging stations.

If a hospital stay is required after surgery, the orthopedic unit has 13 private and 12 semi-private rooms featuring floor to ceiling windows, flat screen TVs, and hotel-like furnishings for a relaxing stay.

A physical therapy suite is located steps away from the orthopedic patient rooms. This bright, cheerful room is equipped with everything needed to start patients on the road to recovery and practicing the important tasks needed to return home.

VISITORS

Suburban makes it convenient for family and visitors to find their way to their loved ones. After checking in at the information desk and receiving a pass, orthopedic visitors can use the elevators immediately to the left upon entering the main lobby or those just outside of the Gift Harbour.
