CMYK (process) and RGB versions appear below each color, for use when the Pantone color is not available.

Hex colors are to be used for web/digital applications.

A black and white logo version exists for applications where brand colors are not available.

A white logo version exists for use only on dark backgrounds.

SAFE AREA AND SIZE

John R. Oishei Children's Hospital logo & Oishei Children's Hospital Outpatient Center logo

Keep graphic elements such as type or other artwork from interfering with the logo. Please keep a clear space on all four sides as shown. The "safe area" is based on the height of type in the main logo.

If using the reverse version of the logo on top of an image, the same safe area specifications should be followed.








IMPROPER USAGE

- 1. The logo should not be stretched to appear wide.
- 2. The logo should not be squeezed to appear condensed.
- The logo should not appear in colors not included in the standard Oishei Children's Hospital palette.
- 4. Do not put drop shadows or glows behind the logo.
- 5. Do not enlarge/resize just part of the logo.
- 6. Do not tilt or rotate the logo.
- 7. Do not place the logo on a background where readability is impaired. Select a different version of the logo (or change the background).
- 8. Do not add elements to the logo.

Logo may not be redrawn or recreated in any way. It should always be scaled proportionately.

The information above applies to all OCH department and area logos as well.
