

**Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS)
Provider Course**

Program Goal

Students will enhance their skills and clinical decision making in the diagnosis and treatment of patients in cardiopulmonary arrest, acute arrhythmias, stroke, and acute coronary syndromes.

Learning Objectives

1. Demonstrate adult Basic Life Support care including AED use.
2. Identify management strategies for patients in respiratory arrest.
3. Recognize and manage cardiopulmonary arrest due to VF, PEA, asystole.
4. Apply treatment algorithms to the care of patients with acute tachycardia or bradycardia.

Prerequisites/Target Audience

1. Registrants must be licensed medical, nursing or pre hospital personnel whose daily occupation demands proficiency in the knowledge and skills of ACLS.
2. It is required that registrants possess knowledge/skills in the following areas:
 - Adult Basic Life Support (CPR)
 - Arrhythmia Recognition
 - Emergency Cardiovascular Pharmacology
3. Attendees must have the physical capability to perform the psychomotor skills for CPR and airway management during the course. This is an AHA requirement for card issuance
