

Kaleida Health's Secure Web Access for Clinical Information

InfoClique is an "online" system designed to provide the medical staff of Kaleida Health a secure central access point for patient information.

system features

Patient information available online includes:

Patient Census:

A listing of your patients as an attending or consulting physician by location.

Demographics:

Basic patient information, such as: name and address, insurance, religion, date of birth, gender, social security number, guarantor and emergency information. It also contains visit specific information such as: physicians and chief complaint.

Dictated Reports:

Most common medical transcriptions (not the result of an order) such as: H&P's, Operative Reports, Discharge Summaries, and Consultation.

Orders:

All issued orders and status for both in and out-patients, such as: ECG/EKG, Nursing Care Level, Echos, Labs, and etc.

Test Results:

Results of orders, such as Radiology, Cardiology, Endoscopy, and general laboratory results.

Medications:

Medication administration list (also known as MAL's) containing Scheduled, PRN, and Historical drug orders.

Labs:

Cumulative lab results containing Procedure, Units, Ref, and Range values over a specified time range.

benefits

Connection to a broad spectrum of Kaleida Medical Staff related information.

A hospital visit list sorted by location can be printed upon your arrival.

Current patient information can be accessed to verify medical office information.

Graphical display of lab results.

Current patient information can be guickly accessed.

No cost other than original equipment.

requirements

Facility Access Stations:

InfoClique access terminal will be located at most physician lounges as well as system libraries.

Hardware & Software Needs:

The minimum requirements to access InfoClique are:

- Pentium II or higher processor
- Windows 95 or higher
- Internet Explorer 4.01 or Netscape 4.01 or higher
- 56kbs Modem or higher

Software Installation:

Kaleida Health will provide the necessary instruction for a simple and quick installation of commonly available software.

Initial System Access:
