Reflections on Developing Pediatric Neurosurgery in a Developing Country

Dr. Leland Albright has been a pediatric neurosurgeon since 1978. He served at the Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh from 1981-2006 and was chief of pediatric neurosurgery there for many years. The early years of his career focused on children with brain tumors and the subsequent years caring for children with spasticity and movement disorders. He moved to the University of Wisconsin in 2006 and served there until 2010, when he and his wife, Susan Ferson, a pediatric neurosurgery nurse practitioner, went to Kenya as medical missionaries, to do and to teach pediatric neurosurgery. They ended that work in mid-January, 2015, and returned to their home in La Grange Park, IL
