## PGY1 Pharmacy Residency Requirements

The following are required for completion of the residency program and to receive the residency certificate:

- Attaining an “Achieved for Residency (ACHR)\*” score for 75% of all goals and objectives of the residency program **and** 90% of Competency Area R1 Objectives “ACHR” (i.e., 11/12 objectives “ACHR”)
- Completion of Project
  - Verbal presentation of project at the NYSCHP’s Residency Research & Practice Forum (Spring)
  - Typed manuscript in appropriate format suitable for publication submission
- Completion of MUE
  - Poster presentation at the ASHP Mid-year Clinical Meeting (December)
  - Presentation of report to appropriate committee
- Practice Management assignments:
  - Pharmacist In-service (1)
  - Drug Monograph (1)
  - Policy Review
  - Pharmacy Newsletter (max 3)
- Leadership topic presentation (1) & all activities
- Evidence Based Medicine presentations (3)
- WNYSHS CE Webinar Presentation (1)
- Completion of all drug information write-ups (5)
- Case Presentations (4)
- UBSPPS’s Teaching Certificate program (Basic or Advanced)
- Orientation Checklist
- Evaluations for all experiences (of resident & of preceptor), presentations, and self-assessments.

\*ACHR:

- Receive “ACH” for a R1 objective in at least 2 summative evaluations
- Receive “ACH” for a R2-R4 objective in at least 1 summative evaluation
